

Names of holidays begin with capital letters. Write the names of 5 of your favorite holidays.

Names of dates begin with capital letters. Write 5 sentences that tell the name and date for each of your 5 favorite holidays. Use a calendar if you need to.

An initial is the first letter of a name or a word. It is written as a capital letter and followed by a period. Write your initials and the initials of every member of your family.

The greeting of a letter begins with a capital letter. Write greetings for 5 letters to special members of your family.

The first word in the closing of a letter begins with a capital letter. Write 5 closings for each of the letter greetings you wrote.

State names begin with capital letters. Write the name of your state. Write 5 more states you would like to visit.

City names begin with capital letters. Write the names of 10 cities you know. Use a map to help you.

In a story or book title, the first word, last word, and every other important word begin with capital letters. Words with 4 or more letters are also capitalized. Using the rules above, write 3 imaginary titles for funny books or stories you would like to write.

In an address, people, streets, cities, and states each begin with a capital letter. Write your complete address on 4 lines:

1. Name
2. Street Number, Street Name
3. City, State
4. ZIP Code

Draw a picture of your favorite book character and write the title of the book under it, using your capitalization rules.

The first word in every line of a poem begins with a capital letter. Write a poem about your favorite animal.

Write a short letter to a friend or family member. Use your capitalization rules.

All names begin with capital letters. Write six pet names that begin with the letters in your name.

Names of important places begin with capital letters. Write the names of seven places you would like to visit.

Every sentence begins with a capital letter. Write 3 facts about space, each as a sentence. Use capital letters and punctuation.

The word "I" is always written as a capital letter. Write 3 sentences using "I".

The days of the week always start with capital letters. Write the days of the week in order, starting with Sunday.

The months of the year always start with capital letters. Write the months of the year in order, starting with January.
